## **Delta's Story:**

Delta was chosen from her litter specifically to become my search and rescue partner. Her sire is an accomplished search and rescue dog, and her mother is an accomplished hunting retriever. Two of her littermates also went on to certify as Type I FEMA/DHS disaster search canines. She has been with me since she was 8 weeks old, and is my loyal and very fun partner.

Delta was named for many of my life cheerleaders over the years. Delta's full name is: Delta Therese Rita Kate Jean Patti Bonnie's Shotgun Phoenix, which AKC shortened to Delta TRKJPB Shotgun Phoenix. She is also known as Delta Force, and has a nickname of Pee Wee.

As a puppy, Delta seemed to be a little adult dog. She learned her tasks quickly and loved working. Her retriever instinct was always strong, and her play and prey drives were top notch. She has always been a high drive dog, able to work away from the handler, yet attentive to handler direction.

Delta has never been people or dog aggressive. In fact, training folks would use Delta in situations where another dog might be aggressive, knowing Delta would not start a fight.

She has been trained for urban search and rescue, water search, and land human remains detection. Delta is a remarkable athlete on the rubble pile, covering large and difficult areas with seeming ease. She's agile and plenty fast. People who have seen her work have been impressed by her athleticism, but they have been even more impressed with Delta's work ethic and boundless enthusiasm for her job.

When we introduced Delta to the hunt, she took to it easily. She never quits looking for that bird until she has the bird in her mouth and is hightailing it back to me.

She's a smart dog. In the hunt field and on the rubble pile, Delta figured out and uses her own efficient strategy of placing herself into the wind to get the scent and make the find. All by herself, Delta also figured out how to place a tennis ball on the ground and wedge it with her front paws and then squeeze so that the ball pops up in the air and then Delta catches it. She's an inventive little girl (she's 52 lbs.).

## **Yahoo's Story:**

A good friend of ours had a wonderful litter of Labradors. He felt so strongly about us having one that he kept asking us to come and look at them. We kept declining until the 3<sup>rd</sup> time, when he really insisted. We drove up to look at the litter and this one little yellow pup was hunting the fence line and working the cover with his nose. We would bring him back to the litter and he would soon follow his nose off in a direction. We pointed to him and said that we want "that pup."

Yahoo was "that pup" and his work ethic and hunting ability is still the same high quality as it was when he was 7 weeks old. Yahoo is uncommonly intelligent. He also has tremendous athletic ability and scenting ability. One of the most impressive qualities of Yahoo is his work ethic. He will try, try and try his heart out for you. He may not understand, he may not get it right the first time but he will never quit, never say never, and he will always give you 150% effort.

Yahoo has produced puppies that are extremely fearless and athletic. They are fast and very nimble. He has produced high desire dogs that are not for the faint of heart, but they are easy to train as he passes his high intelligence on. Yahoo is sensitive but physically tough and his puppies show the same attributes.

Yahoo was so easy to train and as my first Hunting Retriever, everything I asked him to do, he breezed through it. We passed our first Started test together when he was 9 months old and walked through the other levels easily. Yahoo is currently a Hunting Retriever Champion (HRCH) and has earned 465 points. He will retire from hunt tests after he earns his 500 points. He will be only the second dog in Nebraska history to do this, and I will be the first woman in Nebraska to earn a coveted spot in the "500 Club."

Yahoo weighs anywhere between 68 -72 lbs depending on the amount of work he is getting.

His full name is "nv Houston's Yahoo Dot Rascal." "nv" stands for North Valley which was the kennel name of the gentleman that insisted we get a puppy.

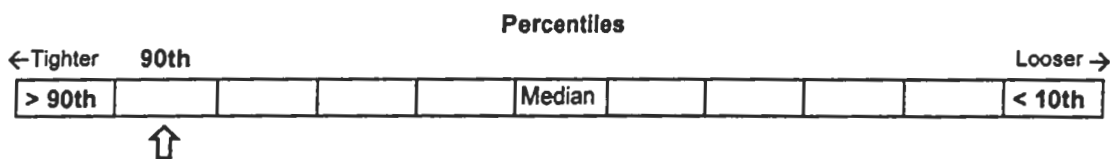

Right Hip	DI is less than or equal to 0.30, with no radiographic evidence of DJD.
Left Hip	DI is greater than 0.30 with no radiographic evidence of DJD. There is an increasing risk of developing DJD as the DI increases; low risk when DI is close to 0.30, high risk when DI is close to 0.70 or above.

### LAXITY PROFILE RANKING

The Laxity Profile Ranking is based on the hip with the greater laxity (DI). If one of your dog's hips exhibits cavitation or has had surgery performed, the opposite hip will be used in the analysis. If both hips cannot be analyzed, the laxity profile ranking will not be performed.

This interpretation is based on a cross-section of 5719 dogs of the LABRADOR RETRIEVER breed radiographed since 1986.



The chart above indicates the ranking of your dog's passive hip laxity (DI) in relation to the LABRADOR RETRIEVER breed in our database. This result means that 1) your dog's hips are tighter than approximately 90% of this group of dogs (alternatively, 10% of the group has tighter hips than your dog), and 2) your dog's hip laxity is in the tighter half of the laxity profile. The median DI for this group is 0.50. Breed-specific evaluations are analyzed quarterly. Consequently, the average laxity and range of laxity for any given group will change over time.

PennHIP does not make specific breeding recommendations. Selection of sire and dam for mating is the decision of the breeder.

\* As a minimum breeding criterion, we propose that breeding stock be selected from the population of dogs having hip laxity in the tightest half of the breed (to the left of the median mark on the graph). Higher selection pressure equates to more rapid expected genetic change per generation. Please evaluate your dog's hip score accordingly.

By implementing selection based on passive hip laxity, we expect the breed average DI over the years to move toward tighter hip configuration, meaning lower hip dysplasia susceptibility. The PennHIP database permits scientific adjustment of criteria to reflect these shifts; the average laxity and range of laxity for a particular breed will change over time.

Please note that the PennHIP DI is a measure of hip joint laxity. It does not allude to a "passing" or "failing" hip score.
